He holds a degree in Civil Engineering, majoring in Hydraulics, from the Universidad Politécnica de Barcelona (class of 1980).

He has been Senior Executive Vice President Water Europe for Suez Environment since March 2013.

Angel Simon Grimaldos has held the position of Chairman of Aguas de Barcelona (AGBAR) since June 2010. This holding company, which has been in existence for over 140 years and includes over 150 companies, is a provider of integrated water services.

In February 2008, he was appointed a Director and General Manager of AGBAR, a position that he held until he was appointed Chief Executive Officer.

In 2002, he was appointed General Manager of "Aguas de Barcelona" and the Water and Sanitation Division of the AGBAR Group.

In 1999, Mr Grimaldos took over the management of Aguas Andinas SA in Chile, one of the largest water treatment firms in Latin America, which provides services to over 6 million residents in Santiago and the surrounding district.

He joined AGBAR in 1995 as the Group's representative in Portugal and in 1998 he was appointed International Chief Executive for the Water and Sanitation Division.

He was Head of the Barcelona Urban District between 1989 and 1995.

Before 1995, he worked as a Hydraulic Civil Engineer in different companies.

He has, among other things, been Vice President of the Barcelona district of the Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Navigation; Chairman of the Hispanic-Chilean Committee of the High Council of the Spanish Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Navigation; member of the Executive Committee and the Management Board of the Working Group "Circulo de la Economia"; Chairman of the "Urbs y Territorio Ildefons Cerdà" Foundation; Patron of the Cerdà Institute; a member of the Advisory Board of "Fomento del Trabajo Nacional".

He is currently Chairman of the AGBAR Foundation, the Aquae Foundation and the Acuorum Foundation.
